Attendance and Punctuality

Homework

- There will be a graduated timetable in September of 2/3 pieces a week.
- This will allow pupils to begin to manage their time, adapt to new routines and attend some after school clubs.
- Homework will then increase to 2/3 pieces per day after the first half term.
- In Year 7 expect around 30 mins per piece. Some pieces will be longer and set over a longer period of time.
- All homework will be set via Google Classroom.



Rewards

- Online system called ClassCharts information immediately accessible to students and parents via smartphone app
- School values ambition, equality, respect, kindness, endeavour, achievement and trust




Music Lessons
